## [Basic Philosophy]

Based on our management philosophy of "treasure the environment and value people", MTC's Technical Development Division (Kanagawa site) promotes innovation to realize a society through the development and design of advanced technologies that support people's lives and production activities.

## **Basic Policies**

The Technical Development Division is a strategic business unit that creates new value through research and development into new business areas. The Technology Development Division, which has a series of design, analysis, manufacturing, and evaluation functions, gives consideration to the environmental impact at each stage of research and development and aims to achieve 'Monozukuri' (manufacturing). This leads to environmental conservation activities, such as pollution prevention and global resource protection.

- 1. In all activities at our site, we comply with environmental laws, regulations, and other requirements, promote environmental protection activities to the extent that they are technically and economically feasible, and strive to prevent pollution.

- 3. We shall promote resource conservation and waste reduction through reduced use and recycling of materials, as well as identifying chemicals with a high environmental impact and promoting the switch to alternative materials.
- 4. We shall set realizable environmental targets based on this environmental policy and promote an environmental management system by all employees and relevant parties. In addition, these environmental activities are regularly reviewed and efforts are made to continuously improve the environmental management system.
- 5. This environmental policy is documented and made known to all employees and other relevant personnel and disclosed at any time in response to requests from outside the company.
